## How to find us

**by car...** but parking is restricted so please park in one of the side streets or nearby car parks, unless by arrangement

### from London and the East

- exit M4 at Junction 10, A329 (M) Reading (East)
- take slip road off motorway, Reading A4
- follow sign for Reading A4, London Road
- pass hospital on left then turn right down East Street, immediately after The Turks pub
- continue straight across South Street down the hill – turn left just before the office blocks and up a ramp into the RISC car park

### from Newbury and the West

- M4 or A4 to Junction 12
- follow signs to Reading A4, Bath Road
- proceed down Castle Hill, look for A329 (A327) Aldershot at traffic lights
- take first exit off dual carriageway, A327 keep to inside Lane, then into London Street (one way)
- RISC is 50 metres on your left
- for the RISC car park, continue 80 metres past RISC, turn left into South Street and left again into East Street – turn left just before the office blocks and up a ramp

### from Oxford and the North

- A4074 via Caversham
- turn right at traffic lights after descent of St Peter's Hill, towards Town Centre, A4155
- over River Thames, through roundabout (Honda on left)
- turn right at next roundabout, Caversham Road
- pass under two large roundabouts and immediately after traffic lights turn left, A327 Aldershot – keep to inside lane into London Street (one way)
- RISC is 50 metres on your left

### from Basingstoke and the South

- A33 crossing the M4 at Junction 11
- head towards Reading, Town Centre
- at bottom of Southampton Street go under flyover and keep to inside lane, follow signs Aldershot A327 – keep to inside lane into London Street (one way)
- RISC is 50 metres on your left

### by train

Reading is on Western Region/InterCity mainline with frequent services to and from London and the West.

There are also Cross Country trains from Birmingham and Southampton.

RISC is less than 10 minutes on foot or a short journey by taxi from just outside the main entrance.
